



A Few Disruptions Ahead!

At the Bedford Free Library

The Westchester Library System is in the process of migrating to a new Integrated Library System, called Evergreen.

Here is what you you need to know:

From mid-February to mid-March: Currently all libraries in the Westchester Library System cannot add new titles to their collections. Once the new catalog is up and running the books will be added. If you are searching the catalog and can't find a new book that's the reason.

From March 11th-13th: There will be no online catalog. This means:

- Books can be checked out but we will not have the ability to renew, check in or place holds.
- There will be no due dates or fines during this 3 day window.
- No new library cards can be issued.
- It is helpful if you have your library card in order to check out.
- Many of the databases will also not be accessible.
- Overdrive (e-book collection) will still be accessible if the patron has already set up an account. The account needs to be set up before March 10th.
